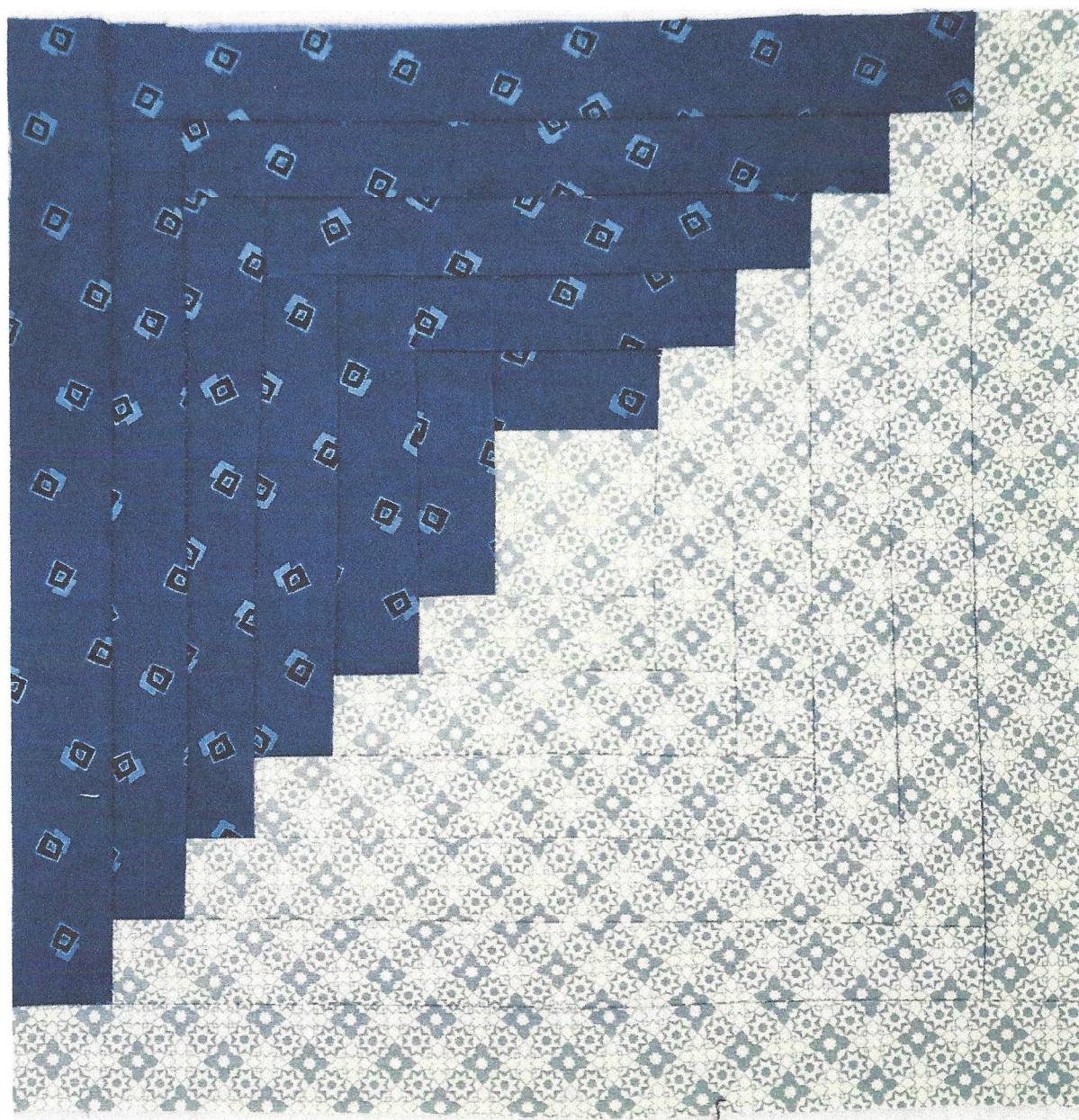


## February Block A



### Log Cabin Block

This block is great for scraps. Just put them in two piles Light and dark

1 – 2 ½ X 2 ½ inch square

3 – 1 ½ inch strips X WOF – dark color

2 – 1 ½ inch strips X WOF – Light color

Sewing instructions : Starting with the dark side, take one (1) dark strip and sew along one side of the 2 ½ inch square. Cut and trim. Placing the dark end on the piece to the top, sew along the second side of the block. Trim.

Take a light strip along the third side and sew and trim. Same with the 4<sup>th</sup> side.

Continue sewing as above keep the dark and light sides the same.

I stop and check for the piece being square every couple rows.



## February B Block



### Cutting:

- 1 – 2 ½ X 2 ½ inch square Light Fabric
- 4 – 1 ½ inch X WOF Strips Dark fabric
- 2 – 1 ½ inch X WOF strips Light fabric
- 2 – 2 ½ X 2 ½ inch squares Dark fabric Cut in half diagonally.

Sewing.

REMEMBER: Add  $\frac{1}{4}$  inch when trimming for seam allowance on 1<sup>st</sup> round.

Row 1: With a dark strip, sew along one side, Cut. Do this for all 4 sides.

Place Ruler  $\frac{1}{4}$  inch from corners and trim on the 45 Degree Line.

This will Set the diagonals for all other rows.

Row 2: Using a light strip and sew all 4 sides Trim like row 1.

Repeat these two rows for 9 rows. Ending with a dark row.

Sew the half square triangles to last row.

Sew all four sides with a dark strip.
