

## **September BOM A**

This block is 10 inch square finished. Remember to use  $\frac{1}{4}$  inch seams throughout.

Cutting instructions

Color A – Cut 8 each  $2\frac{1}{2}$  X  $2\frac{1}{2}$  inch squares

Color B – Cut 5 each  $2\frac{1}{2}$  X  $2\frac{1}{2}$  inch squares

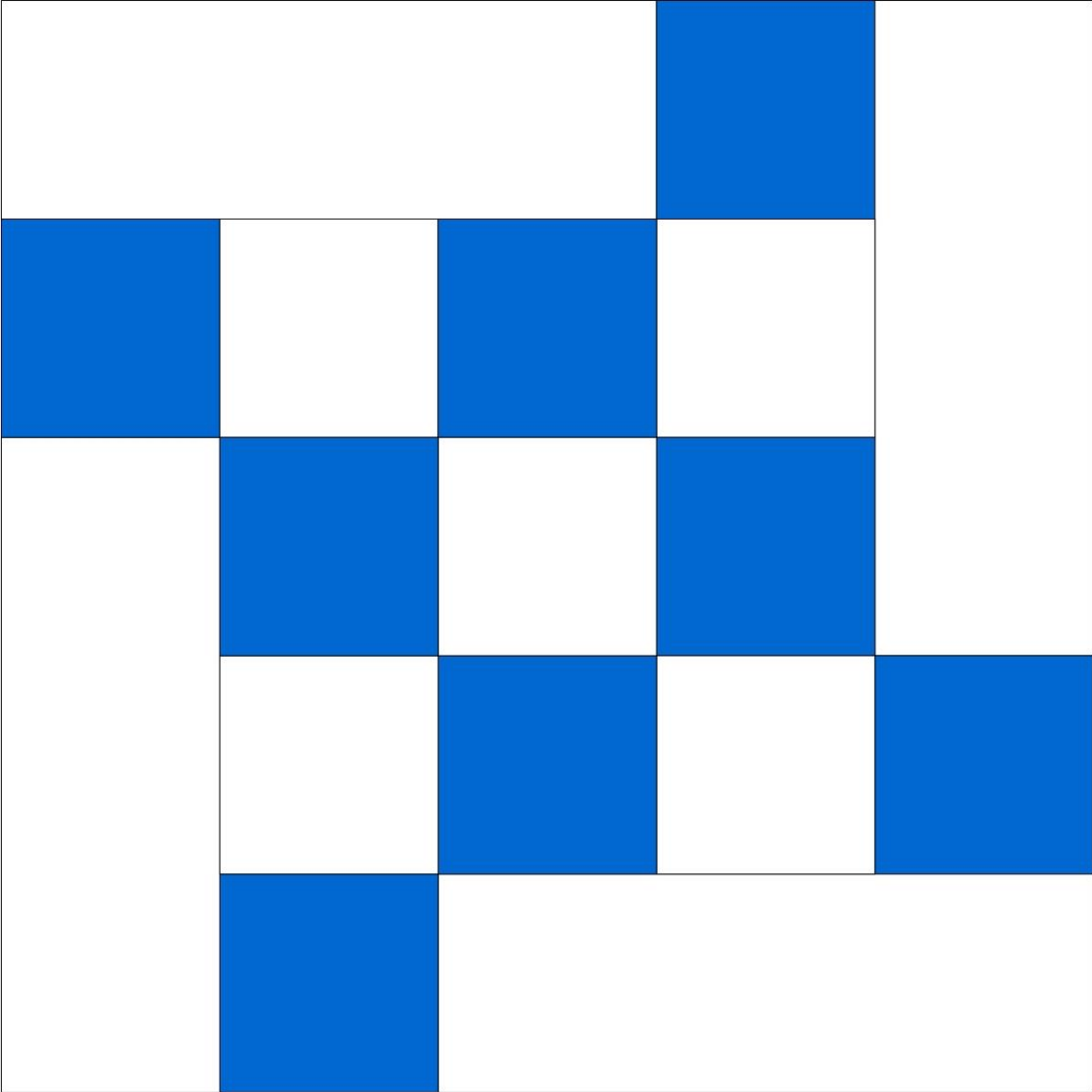
Cut 4 each  $2\frac{1}{2}$  X  $6\frac{1}{2}$  inch rectangles

Sewing

Take 1 Color A  $2\frac{1}{2}$  X  $2\frac{1}{2}$  inch square and sew it to one end of Color B  $2\frac{1}{2}$  X  $6\frac{1}{2}$  inch rectangle. Repeat an additional 3 times and sew aside.

Now for the center nine patch. Take the remaining  $2\frac{1}{2}$  inch squares and sew them into three rows. 2 each rows of light – dark – light and 1 each row of dark – light – dark. Sew the row together with light square start in top row and dark square start row in the middle. Last row is light start row.

With the strips you sewed first, line up the first strip with the  $2\frac{1}{2}$  inch square to one side of the nine patch. Sew to within at least  $\frac{1}{2}$  of the end. Sew the next strip with the  $2\frac{1}{2}$  inch square to the first completed side. Complete the rest of the strips. Once you have done all four sides, line up the first strip and finish sewing the seam to finish your square.



## **September BOM B**

This block is 10 inch square finished. Remember to use  $\frac{1}{4}$  inch seams throughout.

Cutting instructions

COLOR A – 13 each  $1\frac{7}{8}$  X  $1\frac{7}{8}$  inch squares.

COLOR B – 4 each  $3\frac{3}{8}$  X  $4\frac{3}{4}$  inch rectangles.

COLOR C – 12 each  $1\frac{7}{8}$  X  $1\frac{7}{8}$  inch squares.

SEWING

With 8 each Color A and 8 each Color C, make 4 each 4 patches. Set aside.

Take 5 each Color A squares and 4 each Color C squares. Sew 2 rows Dark, light, Dark and one each row Light, Dark, Light. Sew rows together with Dark starter rows on top and bottom with the lighter starting square starter in the middle.

Sew 2 four patches to each end of Color B rectangle. Repeat once to make a total of two.

Take to last two Color B rectangles and sew lengthwise to opposite sides of nine patch.

Sew the two four patch rows to the opposite sides of the nine-patch row.  
Square is complete,
