

October BOM A

This block is 10 inch square finished. Remember to use $\frac{1}{4}$ inch seams throughout.

Cutting:

Color A – 2 each $5\frac{7}{8}$ X $5\frac{7}{8}$ inch squares. Sub cut once diagonally.

Color B – 8 each $2\frac{1}{4}$ X $2\frac{1}{4}$ inch squares.

Color C – 8 each $2\frac{1}{4}$ X $2\frac{1}{4}$ inch squares.

Sewing:

Make four (4) sets as follows

B-C-B-C

Lay first row with color B starting.

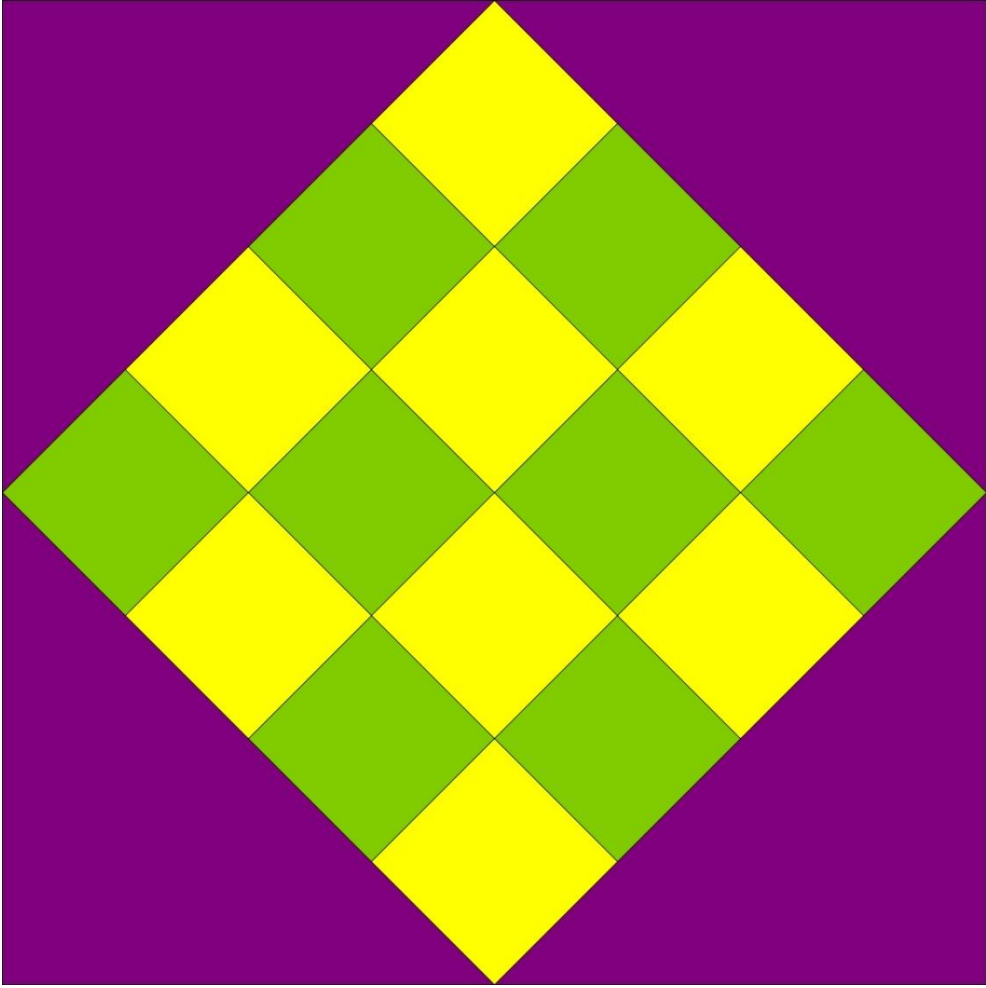
Row 2 starts with color C

Row 3 starts with color B

Row 4 starts with color C

Sew rows together.

Take Color A half square triangles and sew to all four (4) sides of the block. I sew opposite sides of the square. It helps keep it square.



October BOM B

This block is 10 inch square finished. Remember to use $\frac{1}{4}$ inch seams throughout.

Cutting:

Color A – 1 each 4 X 4 inches square

1 each $6\frac{1}{4}$ X $6\frac{1}{4}$ inches square. Sub cut diagonally twice to make 4 each quarter square triangles.

2 each $3\frac{3}{8}$ X $3\frac{3}{8}$ squares. Sub cut diagonally once to make 4 half square triangles.

4 each $1\frac{5}{8}$ X $1\frac{5}{8}$ square.

Color B – 16 each $1\frac{5}{8}$ X $1\frac{5}{8}$ squares

Color C - 16 each $1\frac{5}{8}$ X $1\frac{5}{8}$ squares

Sewing:

Make 8 each sets Color B, Color C and Color B.

Make 4 each sets Color C, Color A, Color C.

With the above set, make 4 each nine-patch units and sew. Once sewn, take 2 of the nine-patches and sew two Color A $3\frac{3}{8}$ half squares and sew on opposite sides of the nine-patches. Take Color A quarter square triangle and sew to the 3rd side of the nine-patches.

You will be setting these nine-patch blocks on point and sew as follows

Row 1 - 1 each nine-patch with quarter square triangle pointed out.

Row 2 – 1 nine-patch with quarter square triangle pointed to the left. 1 each Color A 4 X 4 inch square, 1 nine-patch with quarter square triangle pointed to the right.

Row 3 – repeat Row 1.

Sew rows together and you have a finished square.
